History of the Gallery

The original concept of a Crookwell Art Collection and a gallery in which to house it, was formulated by a small group of local artists in 1990. Acquisitive exhibitions have been held since then with much community support. Many other exhibitions and events were held to raise funds for a permanent "home" for the growing art collection and future exhibitions. These funds, together with other generous donations, resulted in the opening of the Gallery in 2001. The Crookwell Arts Council was formed under the umbrella of the NSW Regional Arts Council and in 2003 became a Section355 Committee of the Crookwell Shire Council which gave secure tenancy of the Art Gallery and control of the Crookwell Arts Collection, as well as insurance cover for the Art Gallery.
